Dear Y6 parents and carers,

Just a few reminders for this week.

Next **Thursday, 2ND May 2019**, there will be the residential information evening for parents to start promptly at 6.00pm. It is only a short presentation and we aim to be finished by 6.30pm. The presentation will go on the school website later in the week in case you cannot attend. Please also feel free to contact your child's class teacher if you have any further queries. We are holding a crèche in Cotopaxi for school aged children from 6.00pm.

The office have informed me that we have a deficit in our final total for the residential, which means that we currently cannot pay our final total to Battisborough House. If you have not paid your final instalment and are able to, please go onto parent pay this week and complete your final payment. I understand that there may be parents who find this financially difficult, in which case I would ask you to contact the office staff.

As you are all aware, SATs is fast approaching and I am pleased to see that the children are all incredibly focussed within lessons and seem to be quite relaxed about them. We will endeavour to ensure they all feel supported and encouraged in the final few weeks to maintain calm for all of our children.

At this stage, the Year 6 team are encouraging children to partake in additional revision using their CGP books or the materials posted on the schools website. It is beneficial to them to do short regular sessions of 20-30 minutes at home to keep their memories refreshed. It is also essential to balance this with an appropriate amount of 'downtime.'

SATs breakfast will be available during the week of SATs - **Monday 13th May 2019-Thursday 16th May 2019**. SATs breakfast is optional but is a lovely opportunity for children to engage in a relaxed start to the day. If you wish your child to take part, please bring a £1 contribution to your child's class teacher by **Friday 3rd May 2019**. If your child has an allergy we of course will cater for them if they participate. It will start at 8.05 which is when the gates are opened and is a lovely opportunity for the children to start their day with their friends and teachers. If your child is not eating an extra snack with us, they of course will still be encouraged to join us within the quiet area.
