TikTok raising its livestreaming age

TikTok have recently raised the age from which its users can livestream from 16 to 18. Similarly, they have also introduced a setting that allows streamers to only have their content viewed by other adults, rather than minors. While we still advise that no primary age children should have their own TikTok account, this highlights the importance of an accountholder's date of birth being correct, as it could mean the content they view being inappropriate if it is incorrect.
