The idea is that each time your child completes a challenge, you (parent/carer) tick off the challenge that they have completed and each challenge equates to 1 point. The reading challenge closes on the 5<sup>th</sup> December. On this date, the book ambassadors will collect in all of the sheets (please ensure that your child’s name and class is clearly written on the sheet, as well as how many points they have scored – up to 30 points) and they will calculate which class has scored the most points.

The winning prizes could include: time with the pets, watch a movie based on the favourite book, vouchers to spend in the book corner.

We will announce the winning class in a Friday Celebration Assembly.
