<p>Objectives</p> <p>To encourage all children and adults to be aware of their environment and to ensure it is safe at all times.</p> <p>To ensure our school community are safe both in school and outside school.</p>	<p>Key Actions</p> <p>To promote a safer environment around our school. Pupil Parliament members to audit the building termly, looking for unsafe areas or particular areas in need of repair. Take part in termly Health and Safety walks. Encourage safe crossing on the zebra crossing at the end of Manor Way. Safety council to write letters to encourage local residents / parents / staff to drive sensibly and be aware of people trying to cross on the zebra crossing. Make posters to raise awareness in school. Look into writing to the local council about the zebra crossing and also the damaged footbridge between Lightwater and Bagshot and having a replacement put in. Showing that they have an awareness for local issues and the safety of pedestrians and cyclists trying to get to and from Connaught School.</p> <p>Identify key issues by considering the following questions: How can we promote a safer environment around our school? Is there a way to encourage children and staff to observe and report any unsafe features or areas around the school? Can we make our community more aware of the need for drivers to slow down and drive carefully close to the school?</p> <p>What do we do well at the moment? What problems need to be solved? .</p> <p>Identify key issues: .</p> <p>How else could we do? What solutions/alternatives could we suggest? Use of social media and school website to highlight the need to travel safely in the school surrounding areas. Use of Facebook, Twitter and school website to raise awareness and increase impact.</p>
