

MAKE A BIRD FEEDER

YOUR SHOPPING LIST

Lard, suet @ £1.80 (Sainsburys)

Bird seed @ £1.50 (wilko)

Fibre Pots @ £1 (wilko)

String @ £1.5 (wilko)



6 SIMPLE STEPS

Step 1 Make a hole in the paper cup.

Step 2 Feed the string through and leaving about 5cms make a good knot so the string can't pull through.

Step 3 Warm the suet until runny and mix with bird seed.

Step 4 Put the cup, hole side down in a mug and fill with mixture. (tip: try to keep the string central all the way through.)

Step 5 Put in the fridge to set. When set, cut and peel off the paper cup to leave a delicious bird feeder all ready to go!

Step 6 Hang your bird feeder on a branch and watch those hungry birds get busy!
