$$9 \times 4 = 36$$

$$11 \times 4 = 44$$

$$10 \times 4 = 40$$

$$7 \times 4 = 28$$

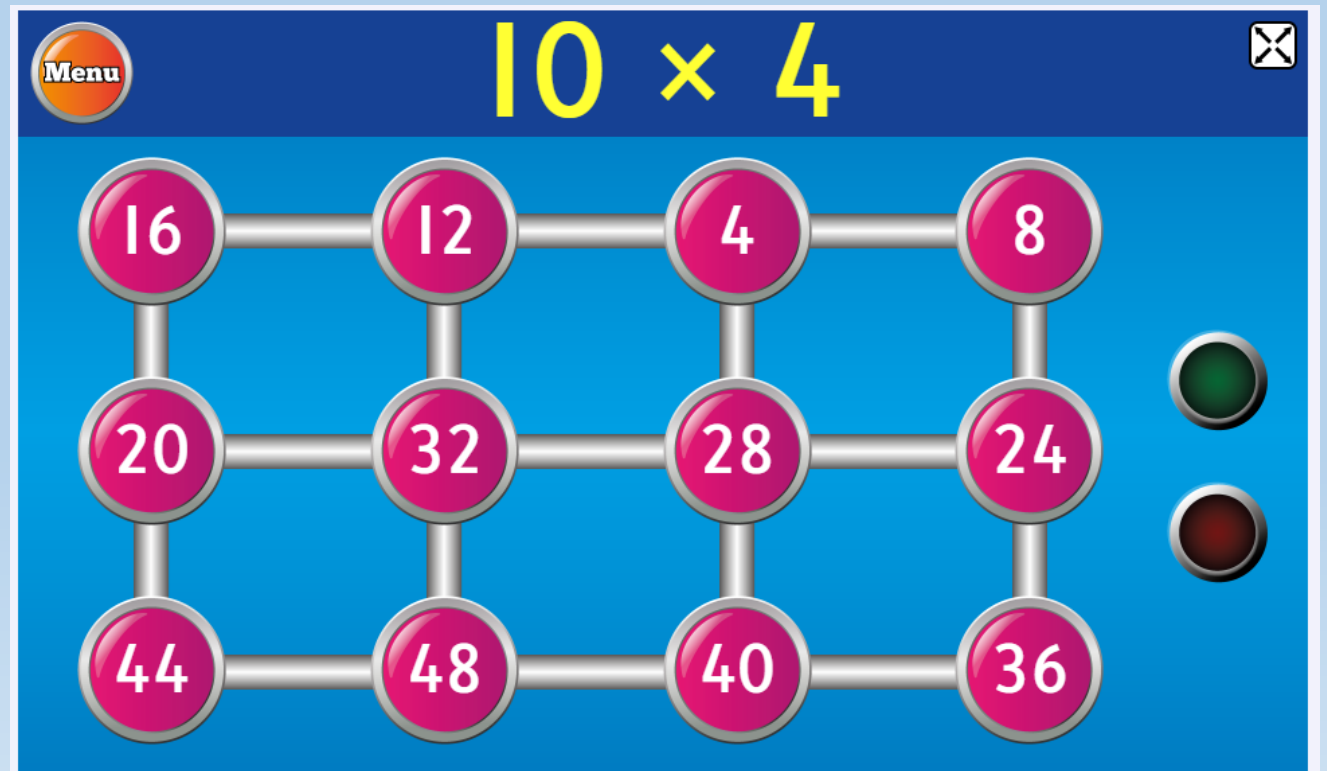

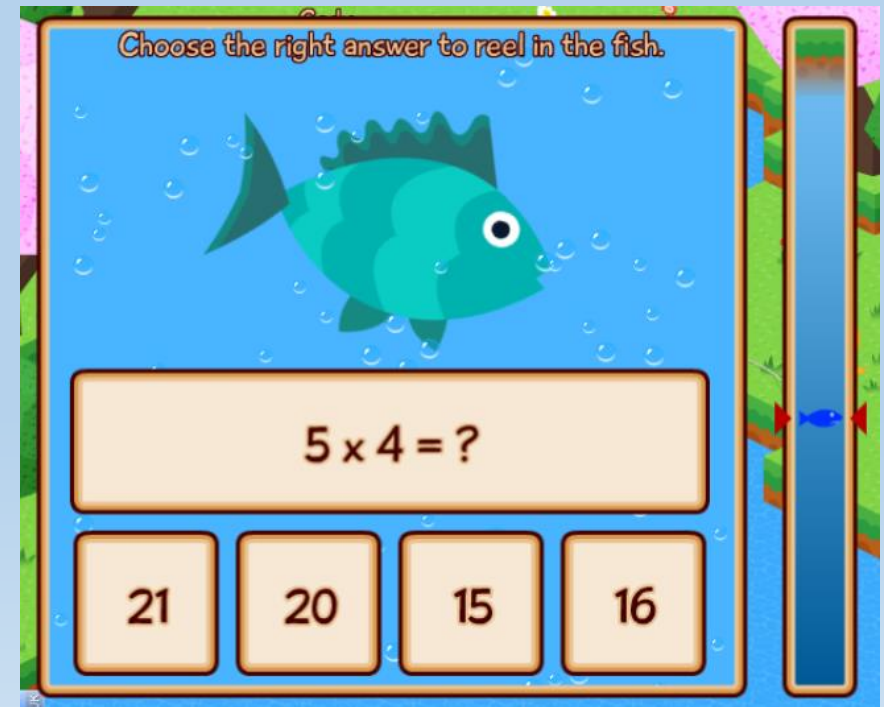

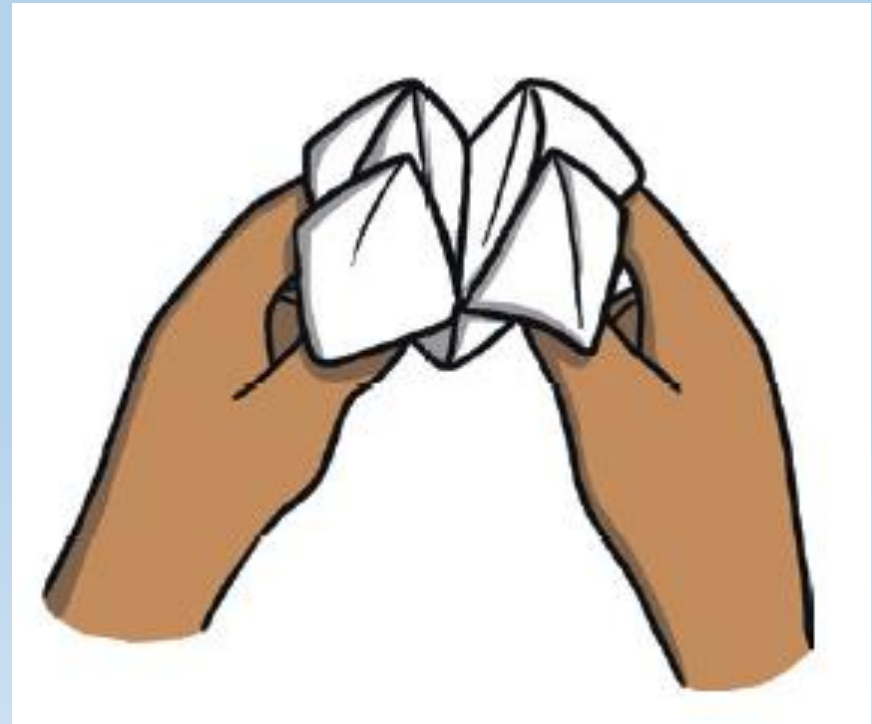
