Transition Day for Sept 2023 Cohort

Congratulations on securing a place for your child at Connaught Junior School! We are very much looking forward to our new pupils joining us in September 2023.

As part of the transition process, we would like to invite your child to join us for a Transition Day on **Tuesday 27th June.**

<u>Bagshot Infant School pupils:</u> Bagshot staff have kindly offered to walk the children to Connaught for 9.30am. At the end of the day, the staff will walk the children back to school where you can collect them at the usual time.

<u>Pupils from our other feeder schools:</u> On the day, please arrive at Connaught by **9:30am** and proceed through the front entrance into the school hall. Here you will be greeted by staff to sign in your child and you can then say your goodbyes. At the end of the day, your child should be collected from the school hall at **2:30pm**.

Your child should wear their normal infant school uniform. They should bring with them a morning snack, a water bottle and a packed lunch (tree nut/peanut free, please!).

During the day they will meet their new teacher and classmates, spend time in their new classroom, and meet the upper-school mentors who will support them next year when they start in Year 3. For their comfort, a designated area will be set aside for the use of the Year 2 children during playtime.

That same evening, parents and carers are invited to meet the Senior Leadership Team and Year 3 staff at a welcome evening which will be held in the school hall, beginning at **7pm**. This is for **parents/carers only** so please make alternative arrangements for child care. Our uniform suppliers, Valentino, will be on site to show-case the school uniform and share information about how to make online orders. Following their transition day at Connaught, you will know the house that your child is in and will be able to buy the appropriate coloured tie and PE t-shirt.

We know that your child is going to be incredibly happy at Connaught Junior School and look forward to meeting them properly on 27th June. In the meantime, Miss Blight (Head of Year 3) and Mrs Littlewood (Inclusion Leader) will continue to arrange visits to the infant schools and handover meetings with class teachers to make sure the transition process goes as smoothly as possible for your children.
